April 24 - 28, 2025 | San Diego, California

Welcome to San Diego, a Biodiversity Hotspot!

San Diego County is the most biodiverse county in the United States. It features a range of ecosystems, including beaches, coastal sage scrub, chaparral, oak woodlands, conifer-dotted mountains, and the Anza-Borrego desert, all accessible within a few hours' drive. This year's theme, Biodiversity, highlights the variety of flora that is cultivated here as well as the responsible practices designers can employ to respect the climate and surrounding plant ecosystems that support local wildlife.





THURSDAY, APRIL 24, 2025

Pre-Conference (Limited to 50 people)

The day offers special access to private and public gardens in mid-city San Diego. We'll start with a tour of Jim Bishop's Mission Hills garden gem (note: this garden has many stairs), followed by a guided canyon walk with an ecologist, an exploration of Balboa Park, and ending with a private horticultural tour of the world-famous San Diego Zoo.

The evening opening reception at the host hotel, the Catamaran Resort Hotel and Spa, will kick off Main Conference.

Please note: The pre-conference registration does not include the opening reception. The reception is

included with registration for the main conference. If you are not attending the main conference, you may

register for the reception separately.

FRIDAY, APRIL 25, 2025

Speaker Series

Join us for a full-day of education with a special focus on biodiversity, featuring speakers including author and artist Obi Kaufman, horticulturist Carol Bornstein, Highline's Richard Hayden, Waterwise Gardener Nan Sterman, landscape designer Pamela Berstler and conservationist Rosalind Haselbeck. Delve into Mediterranean regions and plants, the art of creating thriving habitat gardens, and the transformative potential of rewilding our lawns.

Conclude the day with Dine-Arounds! Enjoy a pay-your-own-way evening exploring San Diego's diverse culinary scene, networking with fellow attendees, and discovering more of the city.



SATURDAY, APRIL 26, 2025

Garden Tours: North County San Diego

On the first day of garden tours, we will explore San Diego's north and inland microclimates, showcasing California native landscapes. We'll visit a bromeliad garden, succulent gardens, Mediterranean gardens, and more. The day will end with a reception at an iconic San Diego brewery.

SUNDAY, APRIL 27, 2025

Garden Tours: Coastal San Diego

On day two of garden tours, we'll tour iconic southern California coast gardens showcasing water capture, succulent collections, native habitats, and ocean views. We'll enjoy a boxed lunch at the beach, where you might spot dolphins or whales. Bring a towel if you want to sit on the sand! Following the garden tours, we'll bus to the closing reception before returning to the hotel.





MONDAY, APRIL 28, 2025

Post Conference (Limited to 50 people)

Post conference takes us to the mountains of San Diego. The day will start at Ilan-Lael compound near Julian, which is the home and art studio of local legend artist Jim Hubbel. We'll start with a docent-led tour of the home and studio, followed by lunch. An afternoon tile mosaic workshop includes creating a keepsake. We'll then travel by bus to Julian, enjoy the view of the Anza-Borrego Desert along the way, and conclude the day with cider and local fare.
